Our offer

The Ukrainian partner universities are working on the German-Ukrainian master program in logistics (GUMLog for short) with the University of Bremen, Germany. One part of this four-year collaboration is student mobility. In 2019 there are **three one-month and one four-months grants** available worth € 750 á month apart from a pre-booked air ticket. Exchange time – starting with a lecture time of winter semester 2019 at University of Bremen: 14.10.2019. Nominated students will be expected to:

- work over a pre-defined topic in the university library,
- elaborate a study plan with at least 3 courses weekly, taught in English and
- make a report / presentation about their stay during the final event in Ukraine.

The nomination will be decided following an online interview. After the nomination you will have to find accommodation and to apply for a visa if nessasury.

- You are an enrolled bachelor, master or PhD student at one of the partner universities
- You are student of the logistics program or follow this focus
- You are eager to learn
- Your citizenship is Ukrainian
- You are ready to cover all necessary expenses for preparation of your study time or any additional expenses during your study in Bremen (e.g. medical insurance, travelling, etc)

Selection criteria

- Reliable knowledge of English (30%)
- Motivation letter, including the reasoning for the selected subjects and the focus of your research (30%)
- Transcript of academic records (20%)
- Correctness and completeness of application (10%)

Please send your application as **one PDF file** (max. 10 MB) named "Your surname-GUMLog2019 application.pdf, including documents, ordered as it is listed in the following:

- CV in English
- Motivation letter in English
- Overview of at least three courses like a weekly time table
- Copy of the transcript of academic records (copy of the original in Ukrainian and your translation into English in form of a table, indicating the grade for each subject)
- Copy of enrollment certificate in Ukrainian
- Copy of passport (issued for foreign travels, if any)
